Residential air conditioning certification falls into the Type II category. The Type I, Type II and Type III test will be made available to each technician. To be certified to work on residential air conditioning, the Refrigerant Transition and Recovery test and the Type II test must be passed. If all tests, including the Refrigerant Transition and Recovery test and the Type I, Type II and Type III tests, are passed, the technician will receive a Universal Type IV certification which allows the individual to work on any and all refrigeration systems.

Students who successfully complete the course will be issued a certificate and a wallet-size laminated card that will reflect the type of certification which they have achieved.

The program consists of a four-hour training seminar followed by the EPA certification test. This will be a **CLOSED BOOK EXAM.**

Once testing begins, **no one** will be admitted or allowed to leave and re-enter the testing area.

**Photo ID is required of all registrants taking the exam.**

**NO** pagers or phones are permitted in the testing area. Students may bring a calculator to the test. A refrigerant temperature chart suitable for the test will be provided.

**ALL APPLICANTS SHOULD BE PRE-REGISTERED AT LEAST 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE EXAM DATE.** The training session alone will not adequately prepare everyone to pass the examination. That is why it is very important that the student study the **CERTIFICATION MANUAL** which they will be receiving upon receipt of registration. **REGISTER NOW!!**

## EPA-APPROVED AIR CONDITIONING TRAINING/CERTIFICATION EXAM



*Since November 14, 1994, only those technicians who have been certified through an EPA-approved testing program are authorized to work on air conditioning or refrigeration equipment. The sale of CFC and HCFC refrigerants has been restricted to certified technicians since this date.*

PPMCSA has contracted with A/C Concepts to conduct a training/certification exam seminar to meet the EPA requirements. Technicians must first pass the Refrigerant Transition and Recovery test which consists of questions on ozone depletion, CFC handling, and EPA rules governing CFCs. In addition, technicians must be certified for each type of equipment that they service. One or more of the technical categories listed below must be successfully passed.

### THE EPA-APPROVED AIR CONDITIONING TRAINING/ CERTIFICATION EXAM WILL COVER:

**TYPE I** - Small appliance systems which are fully assembled, charged and hermetically sealed at the factory and contain a charge of five pounds or less;

**TYPE II** - High pressure systems which are not included in the definition for small appliances, including equipment which uses any of the following refrigerants: R-12, R-13, R-22, R-500, R-502 and R-503;

**TYPE III** - Low pressure systems which use R-11, R-113 and R-123; and

**TYPE IV** - Universal (includes all of the above).

**ALL APPLICANTS SHOULD BE PRE-REGISTERED AT LEAST 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE PROGRAM DATE.**

*CERTIFICATION MANUALS will be sent two weeks prior to the scheduled program.*
