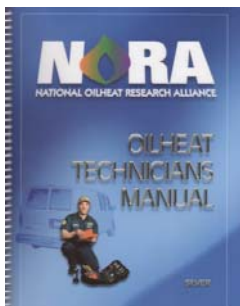

# BASIC OIL HEAT TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION TEST

*Any service technician who has more than three (3) years of experience is eligible to take the certification test.*

NORA offers three main programs: Bronze, Silver and Gold. To obtain certification, the technician must begin by successfully passing the Basic Oil Heat Technician Certification Test.

**This program is a half-day review followed by the test taken from the NORA *Oil Heat Technicians Manual*. Registration includes a NORA *Oil Heat Technicians Manual* which will be sent two weeks prior to the scheduled program for each registrant to study.**

It's assumed that the bulk of the concepts presented in the manual are already understood by the applicant and that he or she will spend the appropriate amount of time studying the information needed before attending this program and taking the exam.

Upon successfully passing (78%) the Certification Test and completing 20 NORA CEUs, the technician will automatically upgrade to and receive his Silver Certification. It is recommended that 16 of the required 20 NORA CEUs be obtained by attending the **PPMCSA-sponsored** seminars *Installation Codes NFPA 31, NFPA 54 and IRC* (formerly Codes and Standards) and *Combustion Technology - What the Future Holds?*
