HAZARDOUS MATERIALS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING

Federal regulations and national standards have focused on the need for safety training and operating procedures at the scene of a hazardous materials emergency. Operation Level II responders are trained to respond in a defensive fashion without actually trying to stop the release. Their function is to contain the release from a safe distance, keep it from spreading and prevent exposures. Operation Level II responders need eight hours of training to demonstrate competency in the following areas:

1. Knowledge of the basic hazard and risk assessment techniques;
2. Knowledge of how to select and use proper personal protective equipment;
3. An understanding of the relevant standard operating and terminating procedures; and
4. Performance of basic control, containment and/or confinement, within operation and capabilities of available equipment.

This program will certify all participants as First Responders-Operation Level II. The program will also describe the background of the regulations, the outcome of emergencies and will discuss the other four levels of emergency responders.

1. An emergency response coordinator from the DEP will review the PA state law on reporting of spills and what is going to happen once they become involved.
2. Instructions will be given on the proper use of fire extinguishers, along with live demonstrations.

OUR INSTRUCTORS: Staff/team instructors from the Public Services Center, Harrisburg Area Community College.

DRESS CODE: Be prepared to work and train under actual HazMat conditions.
