CSA (Compliance, Safety & Accountability) formerly CSA 2010

All intrastate and interstate motor carriers transporting hazardous materials, in quantities requiring the display of placards, are required to obtain and display a US DOT number beginning May 1, 2010. These carriers are also subject to the Compliance, Safety and Accountability (CSA) program.

Hazmat Training 49 CFR 172.704: A Hazmat employee shall receive the training required by this subpart at least once every three years. Certification that the Hazmat employee has been trained and tested must be documented as required by this subpart.

OUR INSTRUCTOR: Dennis E. Lamb, Transportation Safety and Hazardous Materials consultant of Dennis E. Lamb Associates, LLC is a 25-year veteran of the Pennsylvania State Police, where he was an enforcement and training authority in hazardous materials compliance. Dennis has been the PPMCSA HAZMAT Trainer since 1995.

WHO MUST BE TRAINED: A "Hazmat Employee" is defined as a person who is employed on a temporary, part-time or full-time basis by a Hazmat Employer, or is self-employed and in the course of employment, directly affects the safe transportation of hazardous materials. It includes someone who loads, unloads or handles hazardous materials; fabricates, inspects, marks, maintains, reconditions, repairs or tests or otherwise represents containers, drums or packaging as qualified for use in transportation of hazardous materials; prepares hazardous materials for shipment; is responsible for the safety of transporting hazardous materials; or operates a vehicle used to transport hazardous materials.

A "Hazmat Employer" is defined as an individual, corporation, company, association, firm, etc., including self employed persons, who uses one or more of its employees in connection with transporting hazardous materials in commerce; causing hazardous materials to be transported or shipped in commerce; or representing, marking, certifying, selling, offering, reconditioning, testing, repairing, or modifying containers, drums, or packaging as qualified for use in transportation of hazardous materials.

Training of all newly hired employees must be completed within 90 days after their employment. Every "Hazmat Employee" must undergo recurrent training every three years.
